Introduction:

Our institution Dr.Sow.I.B.P.Mahila College was the First Women College in Marathwada established in the 1970 by Marathwada legal and general education society especially for girls who were deprived of higher education. Mass education including higher education is the key to mass human welfare. The dream of becoming our knowledge superpower in near future will be mirage unless there is mass education. The goal of democratization of welfare through democratization of knowledge cannot be realize without democratizing the governance structure of education institutions through its assessment.

The coming academic year was planned and successfully implemented keeping in view the quality enhancement of the college as per the college general plans. The college gave concession in tuition fees for the students who are poor. 26 students are given concessions and one handicapped student is given partial concession. The college has been recognize as a center of Rashtrabhasha Prachar Samiti, Vardha. Hence it has successfully conducted the examination this year. The colleges also organize hobby classes like Rangoli, cooking and beauty parlor for ten days.

Under infrastructure developments this year college had purchased inverters, equipments for Home science, Psychology and Sports department, furniture for library and classrooms. State level conferences of history was planned and organize in collaboration with Marathwada Itihas Parishad.

To develop entrepreneur qualities and to make students financially independent a food festival was organize during "Dhamalnagari", an educational and informative exhibition of onkar balwadi during summer vacation. The college took place in conducting hobby classes to give students the knowledge of different skills. Earn and learn scheme was initiated by Home Science department where the student stitched different garments and sold them.

The sports department also actively took part in enhancement program and it organized this year district level volleyball coaching camp for state level tournaments for fifteen days. Yoga therapy activity was conducted by the department for the girls students are encourage for various cultural and sports activities.
