### **About the college**

The Marathwada legal and general education society established Dr.Sow.I.B.P.Mahila Mahavidyalaya in 1970 with the intention of spreading education among the girls of Marathwada region that have long been deprived of the facility of higher education . The institution in the first girl's college started in this region and has been successful in fulfilling its goals and missions of women's empowerment and value based education.

Majority of students are from economically and socially backward class of society and from rural areas. The efforts are taken to upgrade such students. Seminars and conference were organized to develop the research aptitude of the students. A national level seminar was organized by sociology department state level by Hindi department and intercollegiate seminar was organized by economics department.

Department of home science conducted training program for anganwadi supervisors organized by the commissioner office to minimize malnutrition among 0 to 6 years . children belonging to a backward areas. Exhibition cum sale of products prepared by students was organized to give platform for the students to display and sale their products and to enhance their entrepreneurial skill and confidence in them.

The new building was constructed in the college campus for the provision of additional class rooms well equipped computer lab and music lab was provided for BCS and B.Sc.IT Students and for B.A. Students respectively Hostel building was extended and additional first floor was constructed to accommodate the students.
