## **About the college**

### **Introduction:**

The institution is established in 1970 by Marathwada legal and general education society to promote girls education. This pioneering women's institution is emerging to bring about overall awareness regarding girls higher education in the Marathwada Region . The college aims to provide higher education to deprived class of society and to economically backward students.

The institution has three faculties Arts, Commerce and Science (B.Sc.Comp. B.Sc.IT) At present we have near about 1200 students and about 100 teaching and non teaching staff. The institution is well connected with computers and internet facilities.

Since the beginning , the college has made long efforts to impart education to girl students and to make them confident and resourceful in all respects . The college is proud to quote that our students continued the tradition of ranks in merit list, this year three students bagged ranks in merit list and one students got highest marks in Home science a among all the students of the university .

Workshops were organized by different departments for faculty members of Marathwada Region and also for the college students, to keep updated and to enhance their knowledge.
