## **Introduction:**

Dr.Sow.I.B.P.Mahila Mahavidyalaya is the first women's institute established in 1970 by the Marathwada Legal and General Education Society with the view of imparting education among the girls of Marathwada region who were deprived of the facility of higher education. Majority of the students of the institution are from economically and socially backward class of society, so the institution takes major steps to upgrade such students by providing additional facilities such as Internet Hall, Information Hall, Multimedia Hall, Language Laboratory, Students Seminar Hall, Health Center, Placement Cell and Yoga and meditation center. Also to empower them and make them financially independent, various activities and courses are conducted in the college.

This year special short course were organized free of cost for the students to develop entrepreneurship and inculcate goals and values of the society. The course like Basic of beauty parlor, fall and picko, repairing of household gadget, personality development guidance on importance of family relations, and values of character were successfully implemented students took at most benefits of this course to help students for becoming financially independent by providing them jobs placement cell was established for the benefit of students on 19<sup>th</sup> Nov.2009. This placement cell provides opportunities to the students to make the right choice of the job.

The noteworthy feature this year has been teacher's contribution in research work. Lots of extra reading has to be done for any research. This enhances limits of knowledge.
