**Introduction:**

Dr.(Sow).I.B.P.Mahila Mahavidyalaya is one of the premier institution of higher education in Aurangabad, imparting the education from junior college to post graduate level .It is the first women's institute established in 1970 by "Marathwada Legal and General Education Society" with the view to offer girls the same educational advantages that were then the exclusive privilege of men. The college also aims to make education accessible to all section of the society. Empowerment of women is considered as a priority area and efforts are made to put it in reality in all academics and other activities. The college is affiliated to Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University and has a sustained record of excellence in academics. The institution has adequate faculty members that are well qualified and highly competent. The committed faculty members of all the departments keep abreast of the latest development in their respective field of study by attending conferences, seminars, workshops and refresher courses.

27<sup>th</sup> December marked the completion of 100yrs of our national anthem Jana-Gana-Mana since it was sung for the first time in Calcutta session of Indian National Congress. Since 27<sup>th</sup> Dec.2011 our institution adopted a regular practice to play our National Anthem on every working day at 11.00 am.

A forum "Help women for developing India" is formed to help economically and socially backward students. All the faculty members contributed fees for needy students.

We feel proud to announce that our institution was awarded as "**Excellent Examination Center**" by Dr Babasaheb Marathwada University, Aurangabad 2011.

The institution also got certified as "**ISO 9001:2008**" this year.

Academic ambience and infrastructural facilities are augmented from time to time to enhance teaching- learning culture .With the view of making the students aware about the past history, a "History Museum" has been developed which has

collection of about four hundred artifacts and objects of scientific, artistic, culture or historical importance and is made available for the students to view them.

The institute has well developed language laboratory which brings variations in learning and support both instructor-led and self study situation. It helps for appropriate vowel sounds and comparative phonological aspect. The main benefit of this lab is that the students have more opportunities to speak through recording activities and pairing activities. It also exposes to a variety of recordings from target language speakers to help them visualize how they use this new communication skills.

To encourage students for further studies and to face various competitive examinations, M.P.S.C guidance classes were conducted free of cost for all the students.

To motivate teachers and students for research work”,College Research Cell” is established during this academic year.(16<sup>th</sup> January 2012).

The noteworthy feature of this year was an One day workshop organized for college and university level students on the theme, “Women protection-laws and Remedies” funded by Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University Aurangabad. To create awareness among the girl students regarding the laws and remedies of women protection, dignitaries of various fields such as Deputy Commissioner of police, Ex principal of the college, Media representative were invited as resource persons for guiding the workshop held on 24.8.2011.

The feedback of the workshop highlighted that awareness regarding laws and possible measures was created amongst the participants. It was unanously felt that funds for such programs should be made available by university, UGC and concerned authorities so that organizing such programs frequently would easily be possible in future. There were total 223 students, 35 lecturers who participated in the workshop.

The college has well established placement cell to act as an interface between the corporate world and the students in order to bridge the gap between them and to recruit many more students in near future. The placement cell provides information regarding higher education, job opportunities available through its notice board, news paper cuttings and brochures. The databases of the students are managed by the cell which plays a critical role in getting jobs for the alumni.

UGC sanctioned one month certificate course was organized by “Career counseling, placement cell and presentation forum” from 16-1-2012 to16-2-2012.
